FUN RUN 17TH MARCH 2012



A BIT OF HISTORY

This event is being run by the Bombay Lions Club to celebrate the arrival of the ship "Bombay" from England. The "Bombay" was towed into Auckland by the warship "Curacoa" having lost a large portion of her masts and rigging in a terrible storm off the coast of New Zealand. She arrived on 18th March 1865 carrying 400 assisted immigrants destined for the area now called Bombay where they were to settle on their promised 10 acre allotments. To reach their new home they travelled along the Great South Road from Drury to Bombay, a road that had a short time before been completed by the army.

You will be running or walking the path they would have travelled.

COURSE

5k and 10k Run or Walk: Start at Proudes Park, Bombay Road, Great South Rd to designated return points, Great South Rd, Bombay Rd, Paparata Rd, to finish line opposite the Rugby Club

Half Marathon Run only: Start at Proudes Park, Bombay Rd, Paparata Rd, left to Barber Rd, left to Portsmouth Rd, right to Bombay Rd, Great South Rd to Pitt Rd, return on Great South Rd, Bombay Rd, Paparata Rd to finish line opposite the Rugby Club.

PARKING

Please park in the parking area at the Bombay Rugby Club in Paparata Rd. Marshals will be there to assist. The start line at Proudes Park is a short walk away. There will be no parking available at the park or on Paparata Rd up to Barber Rd.

ARRIVAL TIME

Please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before your start time to allow for the walk to the park, collection of run packs, and the pre-run briefing.

RUN PACKS

Your run number will be sent to you on receipt of your entry form. Please have this

number available when collecting your run pack from the marquee at Proudes Park.

START TIMES

Half Marathon starts at 9:00am.

10k starts at 9:15am

5k starts at 9:30am

AID STATIONS

Water stations and portaloos are located at the return points i.e. 2.5k, 5k, 10.6k and at the same points on the return leg.

AFTER RUN ARRANGEMENTS

Showers are available if required. There will be a sausage sizzle, and drinks available.

Spot prizes will be presented after 11:30am or earlier if all runners have returned.

You all do just by getting out and breathing the clean Bombay air.

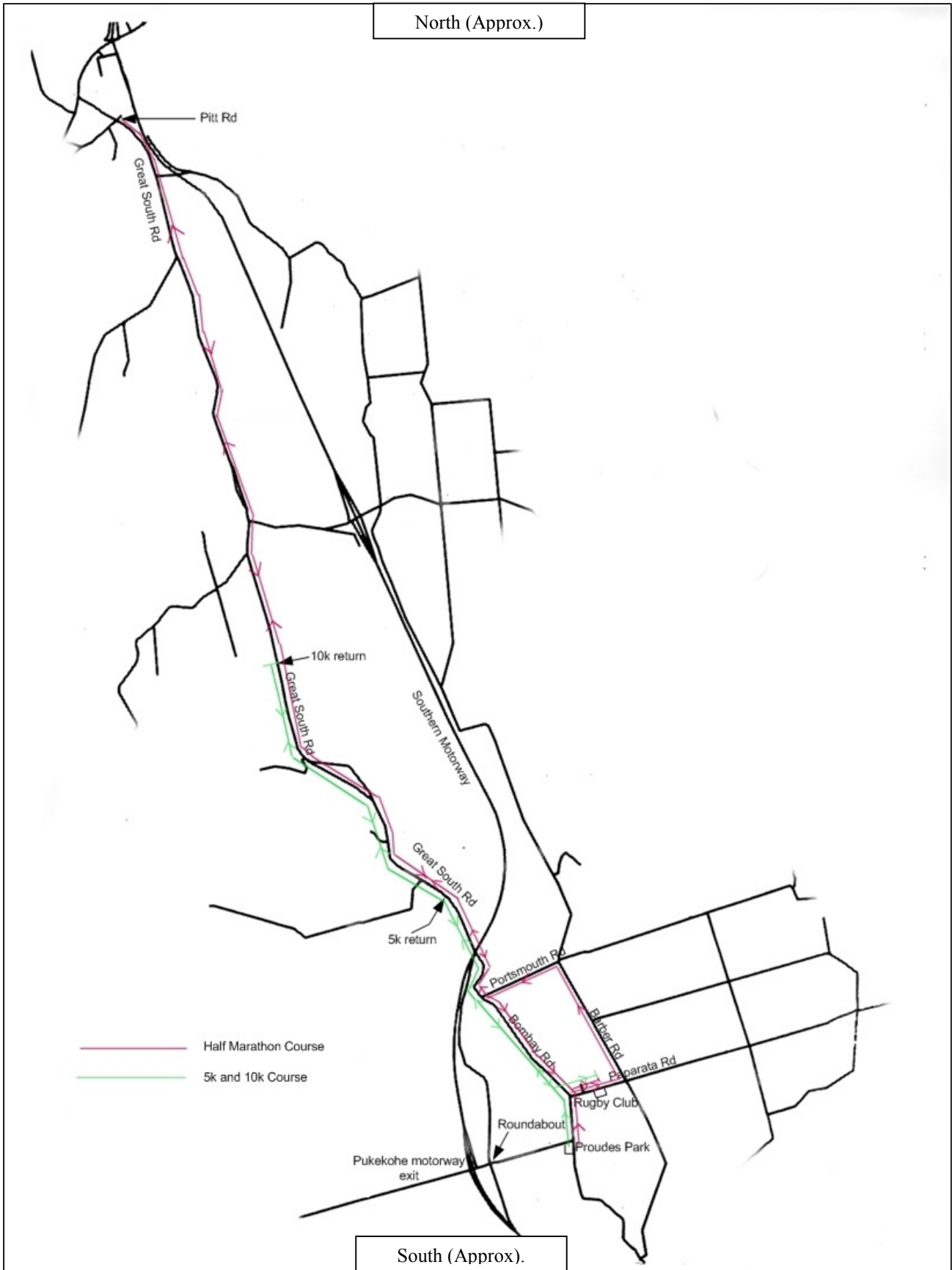
ALSO

RUN RULES

- Advice from Marshall must be followed.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- The run is to be run on the right-hand side of the road facing oncoming traffic except where advised by marshals
- Entrants must obey the Traffic Rules and treat the road as being open at all times.
- Wear your run number pinned on the front.
- Entrants being overtaken must give right of way to faster entrants during the event.
- No more than two abreast once event is underway.
- Marshals will have the right to withdraw any competitor they consider to be under severe stress.
- Official time-keeping will cease at 11:30am.
- At the start of the half-marathon please keep the start line clear and stay behind the line.
